

Mission Mexico Housebuilding Team

Teens, their parents and other adults travel to Tijuana on an eleven-day Mission trip to build houses for poor families. The houses are typically 11 X 22 foot structures with slab floor, stucco finished exterior, two windows and a door. All building is done by hand, without power tools. This allows even those without skills to participate and demonstrates to the Mexican people what can be accomplished with their own resources. The trips have several purposes: 1) to serve the

Tijuana by building houses; 2) to create a first-hand awareness of the poor through direct contact with the Mexican people and their culture; 3) to build our

own community through the fellowship of traveling and working together, and 4) to allow families to grow in their love of God and each other through this shared experience.
